

- Transfer in Seat-in coach in English / Spanish




### Mexico City -Teotihuacán - Mexico City

#### Mexico – Querétaro – San Miguel de Allende

- Breakfast at the Hotel
- Departure to **Queretaro** was founded in 1531, among bloody battles between native Indian and Spanish conquerors. The historic downtown offers the visitor over 460 years of history and tradition through its aqueduct, temples, mansions and palaces. Continue the trip to San Miguel de Allende. 

#### Puerto Vallarta (616 km/06h26) - Morelia

- Departure to Morelia, arrival and visit of the City: Morelia was founded by Spaniard Don Antonio de Mendoza in 1541 under the name of Valladolid, it was renamed in 1828 in honor of the Mexican Independence hero Jose Maria Morelos y Pavon, here we will visit the Main square, the Cathedral, the Government Palace and the handcraft museum.

### Morelia – (59 km/00h42) Patzcuaro – Mexico City (367 km/4.5 hrs)

- Breakfast at the Hotel
- Departure to Visit **Patzcuaro** is a large town and municipality located in the state of Michoacán. The town was founded sometime in the 1320s, at first becoming the capital of the Tarascan state and later its ceremonial center. After the Spanish took over, Vasco de Quiroga worked to make Patzcuaro the capital of the New Spain province of Michoacán, but after his death, the capital would be moved to nearby Valladolid (today Morelia).

### **Important notes:**

#### Regarding baggage:

- Baggage are checked-in to their final destination, but on arrival to Mexico City no exception made, all passengers must claim their baggage, clear customs and immigration and deposit their baggage at the appointed band to continue their trip.
- Only one baggage per person is permitted in transportation













#### **Regarding flights:**

- Only the traveling passenger can claim compensation and present a complaint to an airline. Alico tours is not responsible for a delayed flight or a cancellation
- Domestic flights may experience delays or cancellations causing changes in the program.

#### Regarding groups only:

- Our prices can include a free of charge for your tour leader, check the inclusions list
- These prices include one English-speaking tour guide- coordinator; if you need more staff services, please consult us about the Price.
- Bell boys and maids tips are Mandatory surcharges for a group
- MICE GROUPS: to guarantee the bookings we will request upfront: a credit card or a security deposit to cover unforeseen items.

#### **Regarding hotels:**

- In Mexico, triple rooms do not have 3 beds, will be always 2 double beds.
- Tubs are never guaranteed unless specifically requested and confirmed.
- Check out times at hotels: 12h00 | Check in at hotels: 15h00
- All-inclusive program ends with the breakfast of the day of departure
- Schedule time for free beverages in all-inclusive hotels: 11h00 to 22h00
- Maximum 2 children less than 11 years old are allowed on the same room with 2 adults
- Our proposal includes standard rooms; consult us in case you need superior rooms
- Children of 11 years 11 months or more are considered as adults
- In Mexico, is prohibited to smoke in enclosed areas. Hotels can fine their guests with a \$ 300 USD fine for those who smoke inside the rooms.
- Global Holiday sends the web pages of each hotel proposed so the wholesaler can select the most suitable accommodation. If there is an explicit request from a client, the wholesaler must let Global Holiday tours know it in advance. The expenses caused by the omission of this information will not be Global Holiday's responsibility and it will be charged to the wholesaler.
- The wholesaler must send us the dates of birth date of all the participants, in order to avoid misunderstandings when an ADULTS ONLY hotel is reserved.
- "SPRING BREAKERS" (young American people) come to Mexican beaches during the winter

#### Regarding high season:

- Reservations can be difficult for different times of year: school holidays Mexican or American, religious holidays, etc., especially on the following dates:
  - The end of the year from December 21 to January 15.
  - o From January to April in beach destinations: holidays of American
  - o During Holy Week and Easter: beachfront hotels are overflowed and the cities of Puebla, Oaxaca, Taxco, San Cristobal and Palenque.













- o On May 1
- In Oaxaca reservations are difficult two Mondays following July 16
- o In July and August school holidays in Mexico
- o On 15 and 16 September
- The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> of November

#### **Regarding meals**

If the passengers have a departure flight at 10h00 or before, they will not take breakfast because the check-in has to be made 3 hours prior departure.

#### Regarding prices / payments:

- Credit is not open, all the reservations should be fully paid before the arrival of the passenger otherwise it will be canceled
- For payments with credit card, please consider a 4.06 % surcharge
- For payments with PayPal please consider a 6% surcharge
- Additional nights prices are valid ONLY for an extension of this package
- Our prices are based on accommodation as shown, if any of the hotels are fully booked, we will find alternative on equal standard.
- Our prices are subject to important variation in Exchange rate between USD and Mexican peso

- Our prices do not include tips to drivers or guides MINIMUM SUGGESTED TIP: 3 USD PER PERSON PER DAY FOR GUIDES AND 2 USD PER PERSON PER DAY FOR DRIVER

#### Regarding seat-in coach services only:

- Different category prices refers only to lodgment, transport and land services are the same for all hotels category. (in SIC)
- In our grouped programs (SIC), the seats in the buses are not assigned
- Transfers in / out airport hotel airport or bus station hotel bus station in seat basis in English-Spanish language, comprise the following schedules: 8 am to 7 pm, if these transfers are before or after these time, they are subject to a surcharge because they must be exclusively provided in private services.
- PICK UP WINDOW (seat basis transfers & excursions): Our 15 minutes pick up window means that the VAN will normally arrive within 15 minutes of your scheduled pickup time. Please make sure to be completely ready to leave on your pickup time schedule, so you don't keep other passengers waiting.













#### Regarding technical issues:

- Some showrooms of the Anthropological Museum in Mexico City are constantly in renovation, so they close and other open, please consult us about this
- Museums are closed on Monday
- In Sumidero Canyon, passengers must share the boat with other passengers
- Changes in programs due to unforeseen reasons are not include in our prices
- This is not a confirmation, Global Holiday will start making the reservations when the passenger confirm the proposal
- Film permission fee in each site or museum: 3 USD per person
- Validity is showed: dd.mm.yy
- Distances & kilometers in our itineraries are only one way
- In case of extra nights at arrival or departure, the transfer is lost (if included); please consult us about the supplements to be applied in case passengers would ask for it.

#### **Regarding transportation**

- Air condition in buses is not individual and cannot be regulated
- 2 doors buses are available upon request
- For a group, please let us know if you prefer a bus with or without W.C.

#### **Regarding Visas:**

- Foreigners that do require a visa for Mexico may enter if they hold a valid U.S visa or are permanent residents of the United States, Canada, Japan, the United Kingdom and countries that comprise the Schengen area. Please double check the nationality of your passengers. Consider that the Passport and the USA visa have to be valid at least 6 months after passenger's end of the trip.
- The wholesaler must verify if the passengers need a VISA to enter. Global Holiday is not responsible in case the passengers do not have a visa to enter to the countries offered.

#### Regarding weather:

- Rainy Season in Mexico is approximately between May and September each year
- In Mexico City and San Cristobal de las Casas mornings and nights are cold, Hotels 3\* or 4\* have no heating, it is recommended to ask for extra blankets at front desk.
- Hurricane policies of the hotels are the same as cancellations policies, please consult us
- Unfavorable weather conditions or events beyond our control, may lead us, for security reasons, to cancel some trips.
- For technical reasons or weather some elements in our program may be modified or replaced











#### CANCELATION POLICIES

#### **Bookings:**

To guarantee reservations we might claim for an advance of payment. The percentage to guarantee the overall of the bookings will be set by us and we will inform you altogether with the status of your bookings.

All reservations in any of the quoted and confirmed tours or services provided by Global Holiday assume a total conformity with these General Conditions.

#### **Cancellations-Changes**

When passengers refuse by their will to take the tour, hotels or services reservations, if they cancel:

45 days in advance, there's no cancellation fee 30 to 15 days in advance, 70% cancellation fee 14 to 0 days in advance, 100% cancellation fee

Independently of these penalties, passengers must pay any extra charges in air fares and, in case of cruises: charter flights in air fares or escorted land tours by bus, as well as the charges made by suppliers, for cancellation and administration expenses if they apply

#### Refund:

There's no right to get refund for services not used by passengers during the trip or for services taken whether passengers like or enjoy them or not (like food eaten, sightseeing visited, rooms or transportation after they have used them)

#### **RATING**

Ratings are included for general information.
