Day 1: Friday: La Paz

Upon your arrival. Transfer in from Airport to hotel in La Paz.
Free time to feel comfortable with high altitude.

Overnight in La Paz.

Day 2: Saturday: La Paz, Copacabana, Sun Island



Breakfast.

Trip by private transport from La Paz with a wonderful view of Lake Titikaka along the route (3 hours) until Copacabana (3 ½ hours), a pleasant town in the shores of Lake. Visit to its church and the famous "Virgen

Morena". Trip by boat crossing the Lake to the Island of the Sun (1 hour) until Huacani to have an Aptapi (typical lunch in the highlands), this trip continues by boat up till to the ruins of Pilkokaina Inca temple Finally hike to La Estancia with a wonderful view of Lake Titicaca (1 hour approximately).

Overnight in Sun Island

Ec lodge La Estancia - Standard Cabin

An amazing spot located in the southern part of the Island of the Sun in Lake Titicaca. It was built preserving the Andean architecture and combining with the modern comfort, always respecting the harmony of the surrounding nature and habitat. The cabins were constructed with adobe brick and thatch roofs, and were set between pre-Inca terraces. We do also use solar energy and recycle waste at all levels.

Day 3: Sunday: Sun Island, La Paz

DON'T MISS AN EARLY SUNRISE!

Hike down through Yumani visiting the Inca stairs and the Water of the Eternal Youth, then have a trip north by boat to visit Chincana ruins and the Sacred Rock (1 hour); continue by boat to the Island of the Moon (1 hour) and the Inca ruins of Iñak Uyu temple to finally reach Copacabana (1 ½ hours). Private transportation to La Paz (3 ½ hours) with very nice views of the Andes Royal Range.

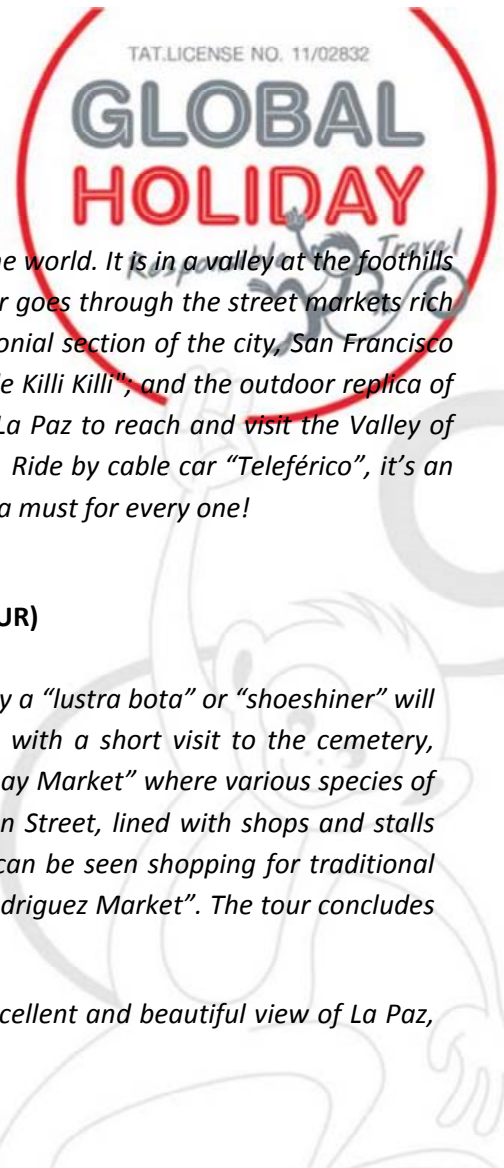

CITY TOUR AND VALLEY OF THE MOON (HALF DAY) (SIB)

US\$ 80.00 Per person (Minimum 02 passengers)



A 4 hours city tour through La Paz, elected as one of the 7 wonder cities in the world. It is in a valley at the foothills of the Andes Range, situated at 3,632m / 11942 ft. above sea level. The tour goes through the street markets rich in handicrafts, weavings and witchcraft items, followed by a visit to the colonial section of the city, San Francisco Church, Gold Museum, Murillo Square also visit to the viewpoint "Mirador de Killi Killi"; and the outdoor replica of Tiwanaku temple. Then descending to the more modern, southern part of La Paz to reach and visit the Valley of the Moon, where a clay mountain has been impressively shaped by erosion. Ride by cable car "Teleférico", it's an excellent choice to discover an excellent and beautiful view of La Paz. This is a must for every one!

Note: cable car ride can change day according to the itinerary

CITY TOUR: HORMIGÓN ARMADO + TELEFÉRICO (HALF DAY –WALKING TOUR)

US\$ 80.00 Per person (Minimum 02 passengers)

A unique visit to the popular neighborhoods and markets of La Paz, guided by a "lustra bota" or "shoeshiner" will provide a different impression of this unique city. The walking tour starts with a short visit to the cemetery, continuing to the "Fish Street Market", the "Flower Market" and the "Uruguay Market" where various species of birds and animals and food can be seen. The tour continues to Eloy Salmón Street, lined with shops and stalls selling the latest technology and to the "Cholitas Market" where Cholitas can be seen shopping for traditional skirts and blankets. Next, a visit to the popular "Belen" dining room and "Rodriguez Market". The tour concludes at San Pedro Square, where the well-known San Pedro prison is located.

Following the tour is a Teleférico (cable car) ride, from which there is an excellent and beautiful view of La Paz, it's a great way to discover the city!.

Day 5: Tuesday: La Paz, Uyuni



Breakfast.

Transfer to the airport. Morning flight from La Paz to Uyuni,

Suggested flight 28300 LPB/UYU Departure 0715 – Arrival 0800 – not include

Meeting at the airport and transfer to Uyuni village.

10:00 am enter this unique natural wonder with over 10.582 km² at 3.692 m.a.s.l. of salt; it is really special! Visit the village of Colchani in the shores to see the locals producing salt. Enter this perfect natural highway to cross it to "Isla Incahuasi" (2 hours), a special habitat of volcanic rocks and giant cactus, Continue north to visit the pre-Columbian Aique Pucara fort and the nearby chullpares on the foothills of Thunupa volcano, then trip back to Colchani (2 hours), enjoy a beautiful sunset.

OPTIONAL WITH EXTRA COST:

LUXURY COCKTAIL DURING THE SUNSET - US\$ 69.00 per person (Minimum 02 passengers)

A spectacular time in Uyuni salt flats enjoying a luxury cocktail in the middle of this beautiful and huge salt desert during an incredible sunset.

Included: Snacks (Ham, cheese, nuts, olives, bread) and wine



STAR WATCHING EXPERIENCE - US\$ 173.00 per person (Minimum 02 passengers)

Have an extraordinary experience being in the middle of Uyuni salt flats at night. It will be a trip to the stars by staying on the earth. It will give an indescribable feeling. (This visit depends on the weather).

Overnight in Palacio de Sal Hotel (Breakfast included)

Transfer to the nearby airport for a flight to La Paz.

TIWANAKU RUINS (HALF DAY) - US\$ 134.00 per person (Minimum 02 passengers)

Tiwanaku is a 1½ hours drive from La Paz (72 km/45 miles), throughout which the highlands are passed and the Aymaran way of life can be seen. Tiwanaku dating back to 1580BC - 1200AC, was one of the most important pre-Inca civilizations and considered to be among the most developed at the time. The main constructions visited during this tour are: Kalasasaya temple and the Gate of the Sun constructed out of stone, Ponce and Fraile monoliths; the Akapana pyramid and the semi-underground temple. Two local museums to view pottery, stone work and learn about the culture are also included on this trip.

Rainy season: (January to March) Roads might be in bad shape. Uyuni Salt flats are flooded. Access to Tahua or Incahuasi might be difficult or impossible. Program might have to be changed due to these reasons.

What to bring

ECOLOGDE "LA ESTANCIA" – SUN ISLAND – LAKE TITICACA

- To reach the Ecolodge La Estancia will have a smooth walk of an hour and a half
- Luggage transportation from the port to Ecolodge and back is done with the help of donkeys, mules or lamas. In order to ease the transportation, passengers shall bring personal belongings only what is necessary and not more, so the animals won't be doing an extra and unnecessary effort. Your extra luggage can be left with one of our representatives in Copacabana.
- Walking shoes for the hike from the Pilkokaina Ruins (3.810 m) in the port of the lake to the Ecolodge (4.000 m – 1,90 km – 1 hour)
- Warm clothing for the cold nights, during the day temperature is pleasant
- Sun block lotion
- Raincoat or rain gear from December to March
- Sun cap or hat and wool hat for the nights.
- Sun glasses
- Flashlight

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Fees apply:

- 59 to 30 days prior to departure 30% of the total final price
- 29 to 14 days prior to departure 50% of the total final price
- 13 to 0 days prior to departure 100% of the total final price

The mentioned policy applies for group or FIT cancellations. Our Travel - Bolivia may charge a higher Cancellation Fee according to provider's Cancellation policy.

Pre Payment and Final Payment

Reservation for groups require a pre-payment of services according to the deadline indicated on the confirmation of services document (for air tickets, hotels, terrestrial transportation, train tickets, etc.).

Total amount mentioned on the invoice shall be paid 30 days prior to the start of services in Bolivia, according to the paying details stated ahead.

Our Travel - Bolivia reserves the right to cancel the reservation if pre-payment and payment policies have not been accomplished, and cancellation policy may apply.

Legal Requirements for Admission in Bolivia:

All relevant information is available at the Bolivian Foreign Affairs Ministry. Please be informed about visa requirements and other important legal aspects prior to your arrival in Bolivia at <http://www.rree.gob.bo/>. All information is stated in Spanish. Please verify the Visas to Bolivia, by clicking on the link "Servicios: Consular" - Visas a Bolivia.

Passengers shall carry a valid identification document (Passport or ID card, according to each country's requirements), and all visas requested by Migration Authorities. If required, passengers will have to carry their health certificates (vaccinations). Passenger's neglect to accomplish any legal requirement may cause loss of the right to reimbursement and may incur in additional expenses, including the authorities' refusal to allow entry to the country.

It's recommended to have a Yellow fever vaccination if passengers' program include visits to Amazon areas (endemic places such as Cochabamba, Pando, Beni, Jesuit Missions in Santa Cruz and Caranavi & north of La Paz in La Paz).
